



To: All DBTHS Stakeholders,

In accordance with Governor DeWine's executive order instructing all K-12 schools to share COVID-19 confirmed positive cases with Dayton Business Technology stakeholders the information below is relative to confirmed cases reported to DBTHS.

On Wednesday February 23, 2022, the district received notification of 1 positive confirmed case of COVID-19. The individual is a student in our 16-21 program. This individual is currently quarantined in accordance to the guidance provided by the Center for Disease Control (**CDC**) and Public Health Dayton Montgomery County (**PHDMC**). Individuals that have been identified as being in close contact with the student who tested positive have been contact traced and asked to quarantine and / or work from home while they monitor/check for symptoms through the designated quarantine period.

It is our goal to be transparent for the safety and welfare of all staff and students, while, respecting the privacy of the infected persons is essential. The District will continue to reinforce the important concepts of:

- **Social distancing of at least 6 feet**
- **Wearing a mask at all times when in the buildings and around other staff members and students**
- **Washing your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and / or using hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Sanitizing stations are available in all District buildings**
- **Encouraging students and staff members who are feeling ill to stay home and monitors symptoms**
- **Frequently cleaning and disinfecting high touch surfaces and nightly disinfecting of all school buildings**

The District will inform the PHDMC of the confirmed case and this information will then be shared with the Ohio Department of Health (**ODH**), loaded into the K-12 dashboard for positive COVID-19 cases in districts across the state.

The District will update stakeholders via, Email, our District Website and a One call if and when new cases arise. The District will share the total number of confirmed positives cases of COVID-19 through our website, www.dbths.org . only as they arise.

Please make sure you stay connected and monitor these platforms to stay up to date on our status during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Once again, it is our goal to ensure the safety and welfare of all staff and students while providing a high quality education.
